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About the College

A BRIEF HISTORY:

The November of 2021 marked the Golden Jubilee of Chakdaha College. With fifty years trailing behind it, the college today stands resolute and sturdy. Bearing the torch of education, it continues to work for the social and moral upliftment of its students. In its moment of inception in 1972, the college was born humbly and out of meagre means, conducting classes in a borrowed space and with a strength of only 76 students enrolled in merely 2 courses. The college has come a long way since then. Today it offers two sections via morning and day and a total of 17 courses which include 14 Honours and 3 General subjects. It is home to an overwhelming strength of nearly 8000 students. With 51% of the total strength being female, the college bears the marker of social progress in suburban Bengal. Further, the collection of nearly 29,482 books that the college library retains adds to its progressive spirit and motif.

Founded by the then-deputy speaker of West Bengal, Sri Haridas Mitra, the college is today governed by abled hands. At present under the able leadership of Dr. Swagata DasMohanta, Hon'ble Principal, the College is trying to reach the peak of development in every aspect. The two pivotal bodies, the teaching staff with 104 members and the non-teaching staff with 32 members, contribute their own share relentlessly to the smooth functioning of the college.

While the college continues to dispense its responsibilities in the field of education with discipline, regularity and sincerity, it has never stood aloof from dispensing its responsibility in the larger field of life. Amidst the carnage of the pandemic, Chakdaha College donated an Oxygen Concentrator to Chakdaha State General Hospital, funded by the college staff and also managed to administer free oxygen service to the local people with the help of the non-teaching staffs. Aware of the debilitating impact the pandemic had on the marginalized section, the college was swift in adopting the Lodha village with around 350 members scattered across 81 families. From distributing food and other necessary amenities to arranging a free Health Check-Up for the Lodha women during the Golden Jubilee celebrations, the college has constantly stood by the community. The students were also allowed a considerable concession in their fees during the pandemic. It is this holism that the seven-day-long Golden Jubilee celebrations reflected last year. The unveiling of the bust of Ishwar Chandra Vidyasagar, the inauguration of the exhibition room, the arrangement of a blood donation camp, the academic seminars, the cultural programme by the students and the alumni, and the felicitation of Honorable guests— all are but figments commemorating its fiftieth year. The tradition of adding feathers to our cap is both ancient and ongoing. Our students are at the forefront of this legacy. Recently, Rakhija Khatun won the Governor's Medal and the DG Commendation Medal in 2023 for being the best volunteer NCC Cadet. Additionally, Sayan Sadhukhan, an NSS Volunteer from our college, secured third prize in the NSS National Integration Camp Cultural competition -2023. As these stories of pride and glory multiply, our college continues its journey.

NORMS OF ADMISSION

1. A candidate may be admitted to the first semester of 4-year (8 Semester) B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. courses of studies on passing Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination in General conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by other State Board/Council, or The W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling, or The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognized by the Distance Education Bureau (DEB) **subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned below:**

In case of other Boards/Councils, a candidate shall have to pass in five recognized subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in four subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

However, candidates passing Higher Secondary examination from vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development (WBSCTVE & SD) or any other equivalent Board/Council are eligible for admission provided that the candidate must have passed in 5 (five) recognized subjects of which one shall be English in the previous qualifying examination.

2. Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 03 (three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. (For example, candidates passing H.S. Examination in the year 2021 will get last chance of admission in the academic session 2023-2024.)

3. Programmes of Study:

There shall be following one type of Under-Graduate Programme-

- (I) 4-Year UG Degree (Honours/Honours with Research)
- (II) As per the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes, developed by the UGC there will be provisions for awarding UG Certificate, UG Diploma and Basic UG Degree with Major. Separate Rules/Guidelines will be framed in this regard.
- (III) For 4 year UG Degree (Honours with Research), a student can choose a research stream in the fourth year, subject to fulfillment of all conditions; laid down by the UGC for implementation of NEP and Curriculum Credit Framework

4. Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

1. 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research): A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other recognized Boards/Councils with at least four subject including English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the UG-Courses of studies on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s).
2. Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects, including Marks obtained in English, in order of marks secured by a candidate. Marks obtained in Compulsory Environmental Studies (if any) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.
3. A candidate shall be allowed to pursue any one of the Programmes in a particular Academic Session. At the initial stage, every student has to choose one Major subject and two Minor subjects.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Students are admitted to the college strictly on the basis of merit. A merit list is prepared on the basis of marks obtained in top-four subjects in the (10+2) Level Examination. The admission process starts as per the notification of the University of Kalyani and WBHED after the declaration of Class XII results of major National Boards and West Bengal Board.

2. Admission to 4 Year B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. degree courses for the Session 2023-2024 will be done through On-line process and the admission will be on the basis of the marks obtained in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination recognized by University of Kalyani and other criteria as stated by the University. Notification of admission is made after publication of Higher Secondary or Equivalent examination results of West Bengal and following the Govt. Order No.: 266(31)-Edn(U)-EH/1U-45/2020(Pt.), Dated: 17.03.2023, No.:339-Edn(CS)/OM74L/2023, Dated: 26.05.2023 and 354-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, Dated:02.06.2023.

a) As soon as the applicant is notified (through SMS or College website) that admission has been offered to him/her, the requisite admission fees will have to be paid on the day within stipulated time through Bank, otherwise the offer of admission is liable to be cancelled. No physical presence is required at the College.

b) The registration must be done within one month on the date of admission; otherwise, admission will be treated as canceled. 75% class attendance must be required for that period.

4. All admission is valid for one semester (Six Months) only and therefore it must be renewed at the end of every semester.

5. Fees once paid will not be carried over for a further session.

6. Document verification: Verification of documents, if required, would be done only when the students report for the classes in due course. Admission will be cancelled if the documents are found not in conformity with the declaration in the forms submitted on-line.

7. Documents required at the time of verification (if necessary) are:

- a) Print-out of the Application form (One copy).
- b) Original Payment-slip/Bank Challan and its photocopy.
- c) Original migration certificate and its photocopy (only for migrating students)
- d) Original mark sheet of H.S. or equivalent examination and its photocopy
- e) Original admit card of Madhyamik Examination and its photocopy
- f) One copy stamp size colored photograph
- g) Original SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/Physically Challenged/Sports Quota (if any) certificate and its photocopy. ***Certificate from either D.M. /S.D.O. only valid for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B candidates.***
- h) Original School leaving certificate.

8. Applicants for 1st Semester admission are requested to visit our college website every moment for any update regarding the admission process.

UGC DRAFT REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009

In exercise of the power conferred by Clause (g) of Sub-Section (1) of Section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission hereby makes the some Regulations called the “UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009”. It shall come into force with immediate effect to all the universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act, to all institutions deemed to be universities under section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, to all other higher educational institutions. Including the departments, constituent units and all the premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) of such universities / deemed universities and other higher educational institutions, whether located within the campus or outside, and to all means of transportation of students whether public or private. For details see the “College Notice Board”.

Infrastructure & Resources

The College Building and Seminar Halls:

The College Building is divided into six separate segments, viz. Dwijendra Lal Roy Bhawan (Arts Building), Acharya Prafulla Chandra Roy Bhawan (Science Building), Amartya Sen Bhawan (Commerce Building), Nibedita Bhawan (Social Science Building), Rabindra Nath Tagore Bhawan (Administrative Building including Principal's Chamber) and Sonar Tori (Central Library). It includes spacious and well-ventilated class rooms, laboratories, staff room, girls' common room, multi wash rooms, canteen, library reading room, gymnasium, students' union room and a playground surrounded by lush green plants. An auditorium cum seminar hall named A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Sabhakakshya with a capacity of 200 seats serves the purposes of academic and cultural activities of the College. There is another seminar hall, Vidyasagar Sabhakakshya, with the capacity of 80 seats has been set up with almost all modern provisions.

Hostel:

There is a hostel for SC/ST boys with optimum facilities for 14 numbers of students. The official procedure for construction of a new Hostel for Girls has been started with the help of RUSA 2.0 fund.

Laboratories:

Departments like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Geography, Zoology, Botany, Computer Science and Statistics Already Have well-equipped and modernized laboratories, which are also updated as per the new CBCS syllabus with RUSA 2.0 grant. Students are groomed by the expert teachers to have an individual hands-on-experience.

Library:

At present, there are 29482 books (texts and references altogether), newspapers, journals and periodicals with updated information are available in the Central Library. Very recently, with the assistance of RUSA 2.0 fund of Rs. 12 lac (approx.), a huge number of books for all the Departments have been purchased as per the requirement of new CBCS syllabus. With the recent implementation of the INFLIBNET facility through the N-List programme, the Central library has become updated and a pool of e-journals/e-books is accessed very easily. Students of both Day and Morning sections are benefited by the Library. The college library remains open to all students from 8.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; 10.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday and 8.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Saturday. Books are lent out to the students on the submission of library cards – two for Hons. and one for General course students. Besides, it has a reading section also. Books can be borrowed for a period of 15 days. A fine of fifty paisa per day will be charged if books are not submitted within the due date. If the library card is lost, duplicate cards will be issued on submission of Rs. 20/- (Reference card) and Rs. 20/- (lending card). ***Departmental libraries are also operative for the benefit of the students within a limited capacity.***

Solar Power Project:

Renewable energy must play a major role in the energy mix for achieving sustainable energy security in the years ahead. A rooftop solar PV system of capacity 10kWp has been installed on Net-metering basis on 05.07.2021 at our Chakdaha College campus on the rooftop of Science Building with the full financial support from Govt. of West Bengal and in assistance with the West Bengal Pollution Control Board. The power generated from SPV panels during the day time can be utilized for powering captive loads and for feeding excess power if any to the grid. RTS plant ensures fruitful utilization and economic value of idle rooftops also.

24 Hours CCTV:

For the surveillance of 24x7, there are 24 CCTVs at present in the college campus, which are installed covering almost all corners of the college. The CCTV footage helps the college administration to provide a safe and secured college life to the students and staff.

Rain Water Reservoir System:

A rain water reservoir facility (Akash Bari) was inaugurated on 14.09.2022 beside the A. P. C. Bhawan. By this facility, the rain water comes from the rooftop of the A. P. C. Bhawan (Science Building) are collected and are being used for gardening purposes. There is a further plan to use this collected water for the laboratory purpose by using a filtration process.

Medicinal Plant House:

The A. J. C. Bose medicinal garden consists of approximately 80 species of medicinal plants. The faculties and staff of the botany department mainly look after the garden and they clearly demonstrate the medicinal/herbal utility of such plants.

Students Benefit and Support System

- ❖ **Scholarships, stipends, free-studentship:** The College extends free-studentship to quite a considerable number of poor but regular and meritorious students. The students' union also helps a lot in this disbursement. Apart from this, students belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Minority categories avail stipends as are allocated by the Govt. of West Bengal and Govt. of India. Female students, on fulfilling the norms decided by the State Govt. are eligible for Kanyashree stipends.
- ❖ **WBSCC:** In 2021, the Higher Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal has launched a new project called 'Student Credit Card Scheme (WBSCC) to support the students to pursue their undergraduate and other different level of studies in different level of studies without feeling any financial constraints. The students can avail the facility of borrowing a certain amount of loan for continuing their studies in different courses under this scheme in Chakdaha College also. - ❖ **College Endowment Fund:** Medals, prizes are endowed by the College to the toppers in both Hons. and General courses examinations held by the University of Kalyani and also to the successful students in the fields of Games and Sports in State/National level.
- ❖ **Tutorial Classes For Doubt clearing:** In addition to the classes as per master time table, each Department offers regular Tutorial classes especially to the Hons. students. Besides, the students from both General and Hons. courses can easily approach any teacher for clearing their doubts. Students get benefitted through regular class tests in these classes.
- ❖ **Canteen:** The College runs a Canteen that caters to the needs of students.
- ❖ **Computer Centre:** Our College provides a free of cost computer training to the willing students in its own Computer Centre. In addition to it, a MOU was signed in 1994 between Chakdaha College and NIELIT (formerly DOEACC Society) to run a Computer Centre in assistance with The Institute of Computer Engineers (India) inside the College premises, where the students of our College could complete different job oriented certificate courses at subsidized rate. The students having employment exchange cards may avail a scholarship upto Rs. 2000.00.

- ❖ **Identity Cards:** Identity cards are distributed among the bonafide students every year. *Wearing those cards inside the college premises is a must.*
- ❖ **Career Counseling and Placement Cell:** It enlightens the students as to their future career – academic or professional. It has been constituted with the following objectives:
 - To act as an interface between the corporate world and the students in order to bridge the gap between them.
 - To act as a contact point for the companies who wish to recruit students from Chakdaha College.
 - To assist students in becoming ready for the corporate world by organizing workshops and Career fairs for the students of the college.
- ❖ **Educational Tours:** Departments of Botany, Zoology, Geography and History organize educational tours every year as per their prescribed curricula with prior approval from the Principal.
- ❖ **Add-on and Certificate Courses:** The Department of Sanskrit will organize a Certificate Course in Sanskrit and a Diploma Course in the Sanskrit language. Additionally, the Department of Botany will offer a Certificate Course on the Introduction to the Utilization of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants.
- ❖ **Grievance Redressal Cell:** This cell attends the grievances/complaints, if any, of the students and redresses the same accordingly.
- ❖ **Internal Complaints Committee (ICC):** ICC has been constituted as per the ‘Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013’ as passed by the Parliament of India to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace and redressal of associated complaints.
