Action Taken Report on the Academic Audit Recommendations (2019-20)

- Strategic Plans to Minimize Drop-Outs: The college has implemented remedial/tutorial classes, counseling sessions and mentorship programs to address student concerns and minimize drop-out rates. These sessions focus on academic, personal, and career-related issues.
- 2. Procurement of Books: Additional funds were allocated to the library budget to procure more books, aligning with the CBCS syllabus requirements. The library collection has been expanded to cover all semesters. CBCS syllabus-oriented books have been purchased and made available in the library to support academic requirements.
- 3. Introduction of Add-On Courses: A significant number of Add-On/certificate courses on diversified areas have been introduced, catering to students' interests and enhancing their skill sets.
- 4. **Inclusion of "Ray" Journal in UGC Care List:** Efforts are underway to fulfill the necessary criteria for the inclusion of "Ray: International Journal of Multidisciplinary Studies" in the UGC Care List.
- 5. **Introduction of New Courses:** The college is considering the introduction of new courses in Microbiology, Physical Education, and Library Science to diversify the academic offerings.
- 6. **Placement Initiatives:** The Placement Cell has intensified efforts to enhance placement opportunities for students through tie-ups with industries and organizing career fairs.
- 7. **Improvement of Research Facilities:** Funds have been allocated to improve research infrastructure, including the purchase of research-related equipment and the establishment of a Central Instrumentation Facility Centre.
- 8. **Introduction of Solar Power Project:** Initiated a feasibility study for the introduction of a solar power project aimed at reducing electricity consumption and promoting sustainability and installed a 10kWp rooftop solar plant in collaboration with the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.
- 9. Faculty Development Programs: Conducted regular faculty development and staff orientation programs to improve teaching methods and administrative skills and organized training sessions on ICT to enhance digital literacy and adaptability to online teaching.
